Youth Art Month (YAM) is an annual observance held each March to emphasize the value of art education for all children and to encourage support for quality school art programs.

txEDCON (TASA/TASB) & YAM Spring Exhibition Rules & Guidelines





Entries allowed based on district size:

Over 25,000 students: 8 entries: \$96.00 10,000 to 25,000 students: 6 entries: \$72.00 Less than 10,000 students: 3 entries: \$36.00

Entry Guidelines:

Current TAEA Member Teachers may submit ONE piece of artwork

(registration, high quality artwork images and digitally completed paramission form unbanded by District Representative only)

- Students in grades PK-12 may participate
- 2D & 3D artwork accepted

txEDCON ONLY (digitally uploaded high quality artwork images only physical artwork will NOT be mailed)

Youth Art Month Flag Design

2025-2026 Theme:

The World Needs Art

Annually, during the month of March, student designed flags from every state are displayed at the National Art Education Association Conference and honored during the NAEA Flag Ceremony. TAEA Member Teachers are encouraged to submit ONE design that will be juried to select the winning entry which will be made into a flag to become the face of Texas Youth Art Month. The TAEA YAM Flag will be displayed along with past winners at the YAM Spring Exhibition!

Entry Guidelines:

Only **ONE entry** per TAEA member is allowed. If you teach at multiple campuses, you can submit one entry per campus.

The design must incorporate the theme "The World Needs Art" and be representative of the State of Texas.

Students should include Texas imagery in the design and include the words "Youth Art Month" or "YAM" if possible.

Artwork can be created on an 8 1/2 x 11 piece of paper with unlimited colors!

Students in Pre-K-12th Grade are eligible to participate!

Upload ONE high quality Flag Design Image and signed, digitally completed Activity Permission Form to the YVM Flag Daybboard by Friday, December 12, 2025.

The winning entry will be announced January 2026 after all entries are juried!

2D media selected must:

NOT exceed 18" x 24" (including 2"-3" mat)

- have a white or black mat (2"-3"max)
- be light enough to hang with Velcro dots

fit in a poster board box

include a LOOSE cover sheet.

Please do **NOT** tape any coversheets to the artwork.



3D media selected must:

- fit into a 6"x12"x12" box
- weigh no more than 12 lbs.
 If there are loose elements to the 3D media such as sand, pebbles, etc.
 ease package those items in a Ziploc bag and include in your box.

Every year, the First Lady of Texas, Mrs. Cecilia Abbott, visits the Spring Exhibition and selects artwork to be featured in the Governor's Gallery! This is a great honor because the selected artists will have their work on display for an entire year!

Artist who receive this honor will also be recognized at a private ceremony in the summer at the Governor's Mansion, where they can see all of the selected pieces of art as well as tour the rooms with docents to share historical information. It is truly a great experience!











Requesting Proclamations for Youth Art Month

STEP₁

Write a letter to your local officials and Include the proclamation form linked below!

STEP 2

Submit a Youth Art Month appearance request for your event!

The Mayor's or Governor's secretary will probably contact you regarding this matter.

STEP 3

Call your local official's office to follow up one week after the letter and appearance requests are sent.

STEP 4

Pick up the approved proclamation with the mayor's/governor's signature and duplicate for distribution!

The Board of Education will usually add the request to the agenda, and public officials are usually eager to participate in Youth Art Month if you will just ask them!
