Youth Art Month Report Guidelines and Forms

A summary report of your Youth Art Month activities should be uploaded to the YAM Report and Digital Scrapbook by one of the following persons:

- Local YAM Chairpersons
- Area Art Education Association YAM Chairpersons
- Art Educators in school districts that do not have a designated YAM Chairperson
- Individual schools that promote YAM activities

IMPORTANT: All local reports will be organized into a state report (or scrapbook) for CFAE (Council for Art Education) and recognized at the NAEA (National Art Education Association) conference. **Please use the report form when submitting your report ELECTRONICALLY.**

The ELECTRONICALLY submitted local report should include:

- A written summary report that includes:
 - Number of years your school or district has sponsored YAM
 - Number of years you have served as YAM local/TAEA chair
 - Approximate amount of funds expended on YAM and list of sources
 - Attach a list of community and state leaders proclaiming YAM
 - Attach a list of cooperating educators along with their schools
 - o Attach a list of art observances, exhibits and special activities
 - Attach any newspaper clippings, photos and other types of publicity (posters, printed programs, proclamations, and/or endorsements)
 - Include some examples of buttons, ribbons, certificates, or other special materials created
 - Include any increases in support for Youth Art Month, art teacher job retention/expansion, funding for art programs, TAEA memberships or local art groups in your school/district/region
 - Attach a brief summary of Youth Art Month activities
 - List of monetary and in kind donations
 - Share innovative ideas to bring awareness to the community about YAM
 - Evidence of increased support for art education in the local area
 - Award(s) of Excellence will be presented to at least one local YAM chairperson

Selection will be based on the extensiveness of YAM activities as well as thoroughness of the report. Make sure to document all YAM activities and events when electronically completing your YAM scrapbook/report.
