# VASE 2023 HIGHLIGHTS









- High School VASE & Junior VASE Events are IN-PERSON.
- TEAM Events will remain VIRTUAL.
- ALL QUALIFICATIONS will remain VIRTUAL, even for High School VASE & Junior VASE in-person events.
- The timeline will change to accommodate Virtual Qualifications:
  - Add/Delete: 30 days before event (same as always)
  - Edit Entries: 15 days before event (used to be 10 days)
  - Upload/Certification: 8 days before event (used to be 5 days)











#### Junior VASE example:




### Timeline Defined for All VASE Levels:

#### Add/Delete:

- 30 days before event
- All entries on your list at midnight MUST be paid for.

#### Editing:

- 15 days before event
- Printable forms are available this day, 5 days earlier than before.



#### Upload/Cert:

- 8 days before event,
   3 days earlier than before.
- Entries not complete and certified will be DNA.

# VASE Qualifiers









- Qualifiers must not have students entered in the event.
- One Qualifier will be present at the event to help the Regional Director address artwork that shows up with a Qualifications issue (ie: wet, unfixed, not the same as the photo, etc.). In regions with a Foreperson, the Foreperson should do this.
- Qualifiers may only qualify for ONE EVENT per WEEK.
- A Qualifier who is employed by a school district CANNOT qualify artwork during the school day.
- A Qualifications Foreperson can only serve as a Qualifications Foreperson for ONE EVENT per Region at each VASE level. The purpose of this requirement is to help encourage leadership growth.

## VASE Jurors









- Jurors will work in-person and must not have students entered in the event.
- All Jurors MUST be Certified VASE Jurors.
- Jurors may only adjudicate for ONE EVENT per WEEK.
- Jurors CANNOT also be Qualifiers for the same event.
- A Juror Foreperson can only serve as Foreperson for ONE EVENT per Region at each VASE level. The purpose of this requirement is to help encourage leadership growth.
- Jurors must be committed to stay through the entire event, until the end of Area Adjudication (choosing HS State Qualifiers / Junior VASE Platinum Level.

# Originality Concern









With the growing popularity of AI (artificial intelligence) apps that generate artwork from only typed-in words, VASE Teachers, Qualifiers, Jurors, and Students need to be aware that any image generated by and AI app is NOT eligible for VASE.

VASE entries must have <u>documented references that are ORIGINAL to the student</u>. Originality evidence includes reference photos, reference sketches, and observation & imagination documentation, all of which must be included in the Reference PDF and noted in the Student Intent & Artwork Identification Form checkboxes.

Examples of AI apps include Wombo Dream, Wonder, Midjourney, and many, many more; if teachers have found them, we KNOW students have, too. While these apps are LOTS of fun, they are not to be used as VASE entries and/or references.
