



Rules and Guidelines

YAM State Capitol Exhibit and TASA/TASB Exhibit

Entry Fee: Each entry will be assessed a fee at **\$10 per piece**. This fee helps to cover the cost of returning artwork, mailing notifications and printing programs and certificates.

ONLINE REGISTRATION IS MANDATORY FOR TAEA SPONSORED EXHIBITS. Please check with your **District Coordinator/Supervisor** about the online registration process for your area.

***Online registration: August 6 – September 3, 2021 for TASA/TASB Exhibit
October 8 – December 10, 2021 for State Capitol Exhibit***

After you have registered online, proofread ALL data entered. Check to make sure all names and addresses are entered correctly. Enter information using **normal punctuation and capitalizations.**

DO NOT USE ALL CAPS OR ALL LOWERCASE LETTERS WHEN ENTERING DATA. All artwork labels, mailing labels, certificates and program contents are generated from YOUR ONLINE ENTRY TYPING!

School District Rules and guidelines for entries:

Over 25,000 students, eight (8) entries: \$80.00
10,000 to 25,000 students, six (6) entries: \$60.00
Less than 10,000 students, three (3) entries: \$30.00
Private and Single Schools, one (1) entry: \$10.00

Remember that participation in both YAM events is required for **District of Distinction** honors!

Requirements:

- A teacher who is a current **TAEA member** may submit **ONE** artwork. Teachers who teach on more than one campus may submit one artwork from each campus.
- Students in grades Pre K through 12 may participate.
- Individual entries only – **NO GROUP PROJECTS**
- 2-D flat work, **please fix charcoals and pastels.**
- **3-D media, submit and mat one high resolution photo along with either two smaller additional view photos on the front OR a QR code to a short video or 3D rendered image. See artwork display example.**
- **NO STRETCHED CANVAS OR WOOD** – This artwork will not be hung as the display panels are made for lightweight work.
- **MAXIMUM SIZE** of artwork entry (including mat) **18”X24”.**
- **WHITE MAT ONLY**, no acetate, no frames or glass. Make sure all artwork is **securely matted (no thinner than 2 inches, no wider than 3 inches please) with a secure backing of cardboard.**
- Neat, high quality student work created within the calendar year should be sent.
- **NO COPY WORK or plagiarism. In keeping with the TEKS**, artwork must be original in thought, design, and execution. Copying or reproducing a published image is not original and will not be selected.
- Students’ own photographs or student-directed photographs may be used as a source; **teacher’s photographs should not be used.**
- **Artwork not meeting these requirements will not be selected.**

- Photographs that are painted or drawn over must be the student's original or student directed photograph, not one that has been published.
- Images should not be traced with the use of any projection device.
- **All entries must be created solely and exclusively by the student.** No one other than the artist of record may work directly on or manipulate any artwork entered in YAM or TASB; this includes parents, teachers/sponsors, private teachers, mentors, or other collaborators.
- **Artwork submitted for YAM or TASB may only be entered for one of these events.** If a work is shown, the same work may not be re-entered in the other event.
- Artwork content must be appropriate for the school, community and for young audiences. Artwork with questionable content will not be selected.

Labeling and Packaging:

- **Use the student artwork permission form in this document. Do not use older versions of this form. Please fill in the form electronically before printing to be sent home for parent signature.**
- **Make 2 copies of the completed student artwork permission form.** Attach the **original** to the artwork and keep one for your records.
- Once registration is complete, you will receive a link to a district folder to upload a copy of the artwork and permission form.
 - Please label artwork: **DistrictISD.FirstLast.Grade.jpg**, and form: **DistrictISD.FirstLast.Grade.pdf**
- Ship all district entries in a sturdy, reusable box. **Please use the smallest box possible that is appropriate for the size of entries...a poster board box is ideal!**
- To prevent shipping damage, pack artwork in a flat cardboard box. Place a **LOOSE** cover sheet between the work. Please do not attach the cover sheet to the work.
- In a large envelope, place the following:
 - **District Artwork Inventory List**
 - **Thumbnail Images of all artwork submitted**

NOTE: TAEA is not responsible for damaged or lost artwork.

For 2021 TASA/TASB Entries, artwork and forms should be submitted to the shared folder, then mail original work and documentation to:

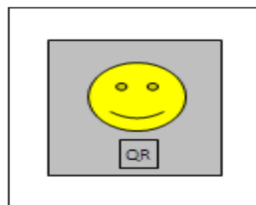
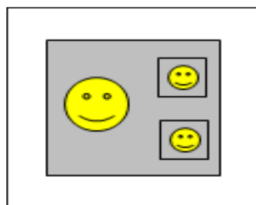
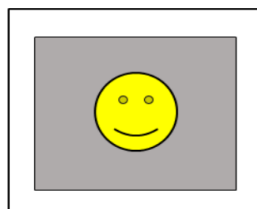
2020 YAM State Capitol Exhibit Update: Electronic Submissions for Exhibit Selection!

Once artwork has been juried and selected, physical artwork should be mailed to above address.

FRONT – ARTWORK

- WHITE mat (2"-3" please)
- Not too heavy to hang with Velcro dots
- Cover sheet (to protect artwork)
- Do not tape over the forms
- 3-D – one high-resolution photo with two smaller additional views or a QR code to a short video or 3D rendered image

BACK

- Sturdy backing (cardboard or mat board)
- Attach original Student/Parent Artwork Release Form
- Attach in the direction the art should hang OR draw an UP arrow indicating hanging direction
