## STATE VASE PORTFOLIO REVIEW STUDENT RECOMMENDATIONS



1. Students should bring their best fifteen (15) pieces of artwork.
  - a. Focus on-
    - Series/Concentration
    - Sketchbooks
    - Thematic/Conceptual – Original Artwork
  - b. **Suggestion:** Bring fewer required assignments such as still life and self-portraits.
  
2. If students have their artwork in digital format, they need to bring their own laptop, flash drive, etc. Students must be prepared to show their artwork.
  
3. Cell phone artwork presentations would be considered inappropriate.
  
4. Students need to organize their thoughts and be prepared to discuss their artwork.
